## *Library Donations*

*The Jackson County Public Library welcomes donations from members of our community. The library will acknowledge gifts of \$100 or more on a bronze recognition tree leaf prominently displayed in the Seymour Library lobby. Engraved stones will display names of those donating at least \$1,500. Donors may give money in the name of a business, individual or as a memorial.*

*Purchasing gift and memorial books is a wonderful and unique way to remember loved ones or to mark special occasions such as births, birthdays, graduations, weddings and anniversaries. Civic-minded businesses might also want to make a contribution to the community by contacting the Head of Information Services and donating a reference set or magazine subscription to the library.*

*With your contribution, the Library will purchase an item in the category you choose. For instance, if the person you are honoring with a memorial book was an avid gardener, the library will be happy to enhance its collection by selecting a book about gardening. If you are a physician, you may choose to sponsor a donation to the health reference collection.*

*Acknowledgement of your gift is sent to the individual or the family of the person being honored. A bookplate imprinted with your name and the name of the person being honored is placed in the book before it goes on the shelf for check-out.*
