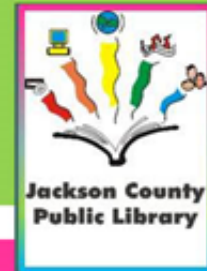

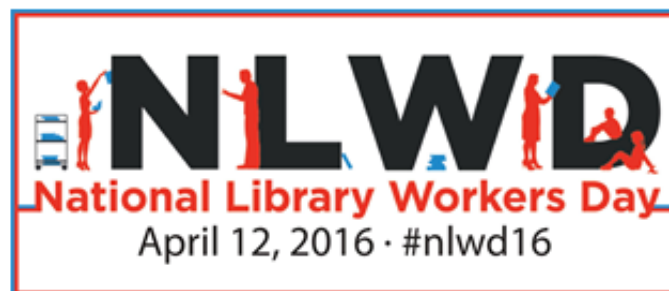


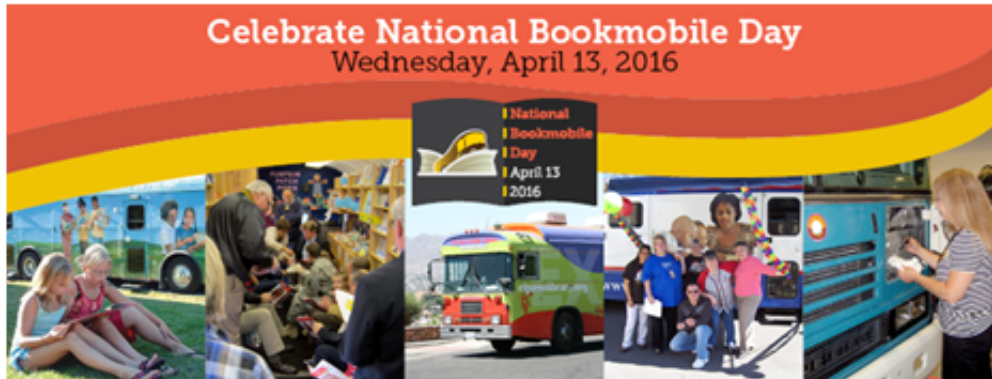

### **The State of Libraries in the U.S.**

There are an estimated 9,082 public libraries and 119,487 libraries of all kinds in the United States today. About 136,851 paid staff work in public libraries. The "Public Libraries in the United States Survey FY 2012 Fast Facts" shows that there were 1.5 billion in-person visits to public libraries across the United States, similar to 2011 levels. This was a 10-year increase of 20.7 percent.
