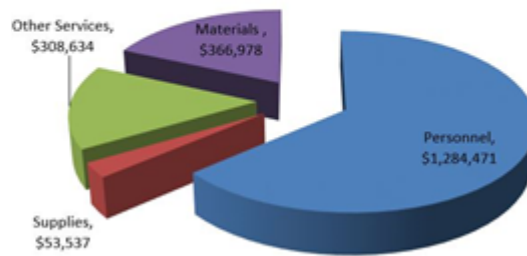
Jami started her job as a Youth Services Program Assistant on March 20. Jami is from Brownstown. She enjoys visiting State Parks, traveling, and hiking.

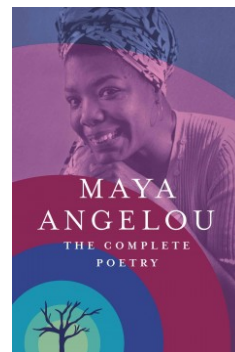
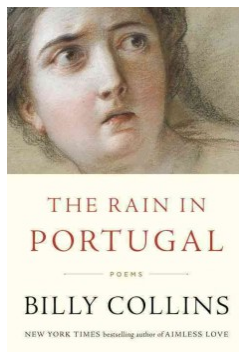
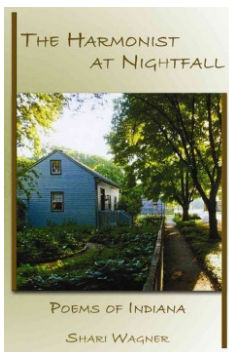

One entry slip per person per day. Entry slips must be legible to be eligible.

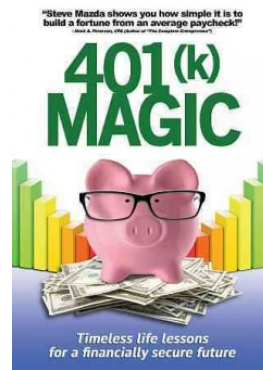
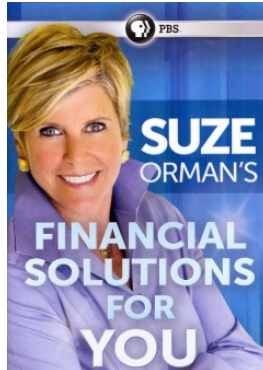
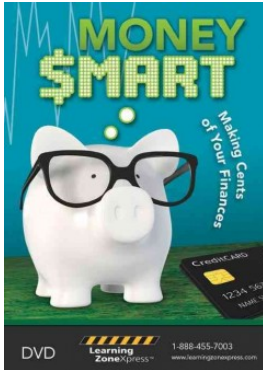
