REQUIREMENTS

- · Willingness to learn and participate in everyday library activities (shelving, cleaning, etc.).
- · Must be self-motivated and able to stay on task without direct supervision.
- · Must be available to work approximately 10 hrs. per week as scheduled. Mandatory dates are: 6/4, 6/6, 6/9, 6/14, 7/2, 7/21, and 7/27.
