

Food for Fines

This year's JCPL food drive will take place August 16-30. Last August, the Jackson County Public Library Food for Fines programs netted these fines waived and items donated to the local food banks:

Seymour - \$1,314.37 fines waived and 1,329 items donated Crothersville - \$639.26 fines waived and 663 items donated Medora - \$135.75 fines waived and 142 items donated Total - \$2,089.38 fines waived and 2,134 food items donated

These food banks are very low on supplies of food for hungry individuals in our county.

- Please donate food and waive fines. You can even do this for someone else.
- He or she can perhaps check out things from the library while others can eat!
- Bring any non-perishable food donation to any Jackson County Public Library location.
- 1 non-perishable food item equals \$1 or less in overdue charges forgiven.
- Library cardholders with collection agency accounts may participate after paying the \$10 collection agency account fee. All materials must be returned before the fines can be waived.

Since 1991, the library has accepted 76,096 items and waived \$62,388.75 in overdue fines.
